MY SCHOOL DATA TO BOOST TRANSPARENCY AND CHOICE FOR FAMILIES

Shadow Minister for Education and Early Learning, Julian Leeser, has welcomed the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority's (ACRA) update to the My School website.

The latest update, released today includes:

- 2025 NAPLAN results for each school
- 2023–25 student progress data, showing how much the same students at the same school have improved over two years
- 2025 school profile, census and attendance data (Semester 1)
- 2024 school financial information, including recurrent funding and capital expenditure
- 2024 vocational education and training (VET) participation and outcomes
- 2024 Year 12 certification information.

Mr Leeser said My School is a critical tool for families considering the best education for their children, and that the data released on the website today is an important step for parents' school choice.

“Greater transparency strengthens trust in our education system and our diverse mix of government, Catholic and independent schools,” Mr Leeser said.

“When information is easy to access and understand, it supports choice for parents and helps governments tailor policy and support where it is needed most. That’s how we lift standards across the board and ensure every student benefits, no matter which school they attend.”
